

How do I create a scratch account?

- Access a browser (Chrome, Mozilla, Firefox, etc.).
- click on the link or the image below: <https://scratch.mit.edu/>



- The Scratch homepage will open
- Click on "**Join the Scratch community**" in the top right-hand corner





– Select the country (if you select “Italy”, the instructions will be in Italian)



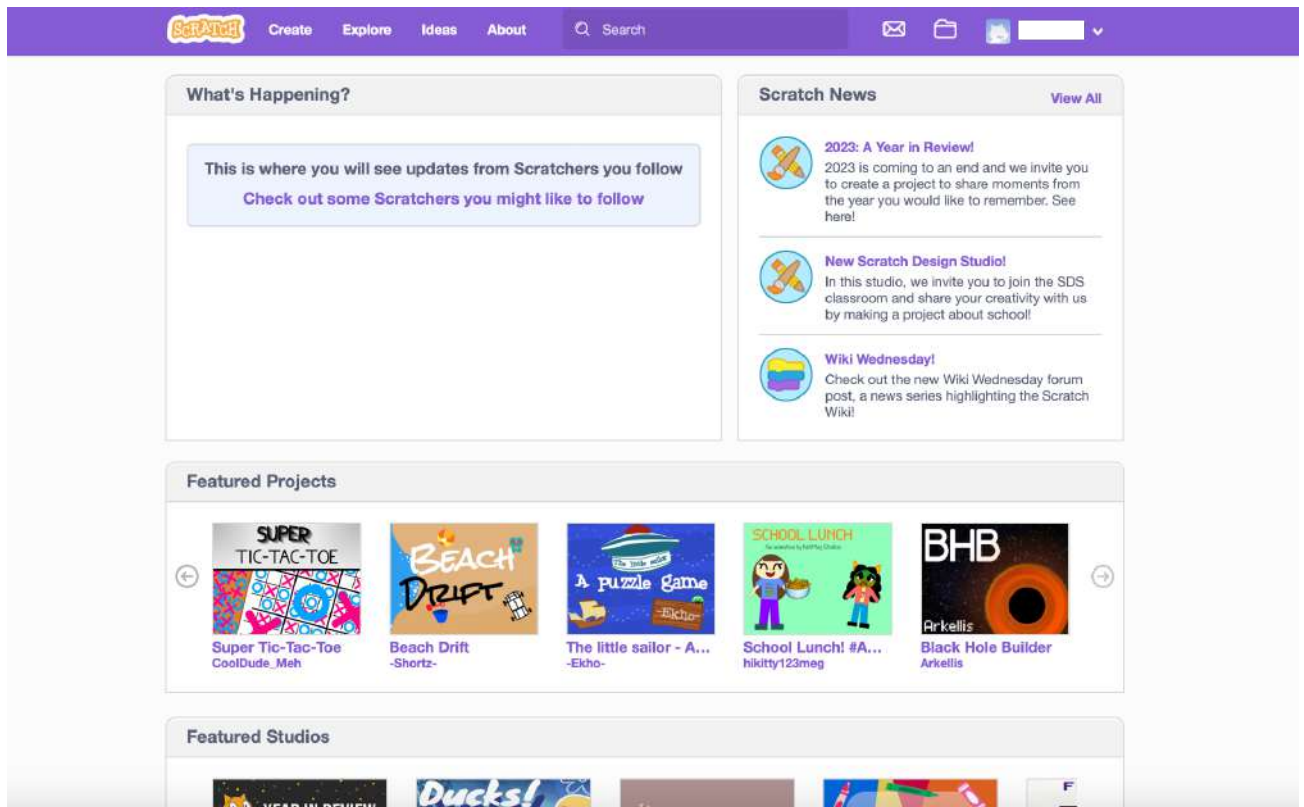
– Click on su **“Confirm my account”** or on thee light blue link

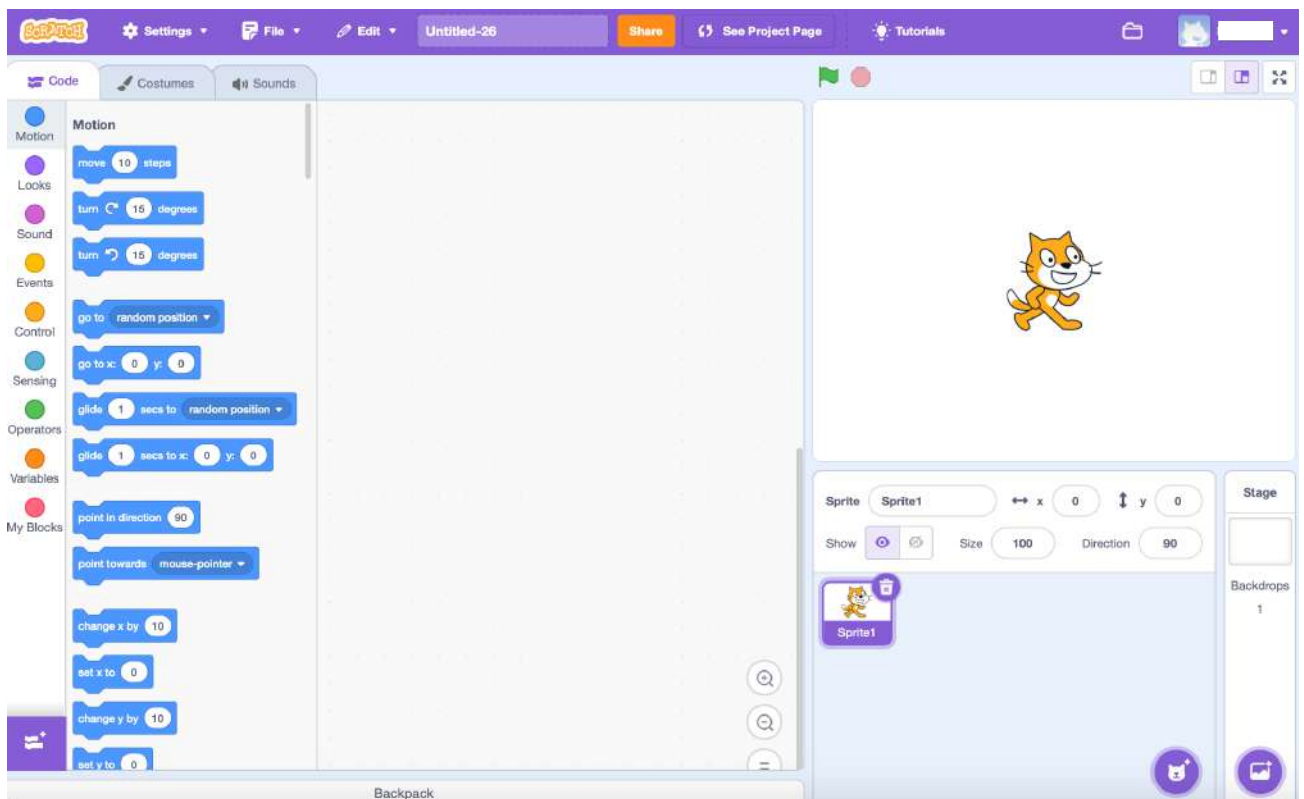
– if you will have correctly confirmed your account a welcome page will appear



How do I open a project on scratch?

– Click on “**Create**” on the top left corner of the page



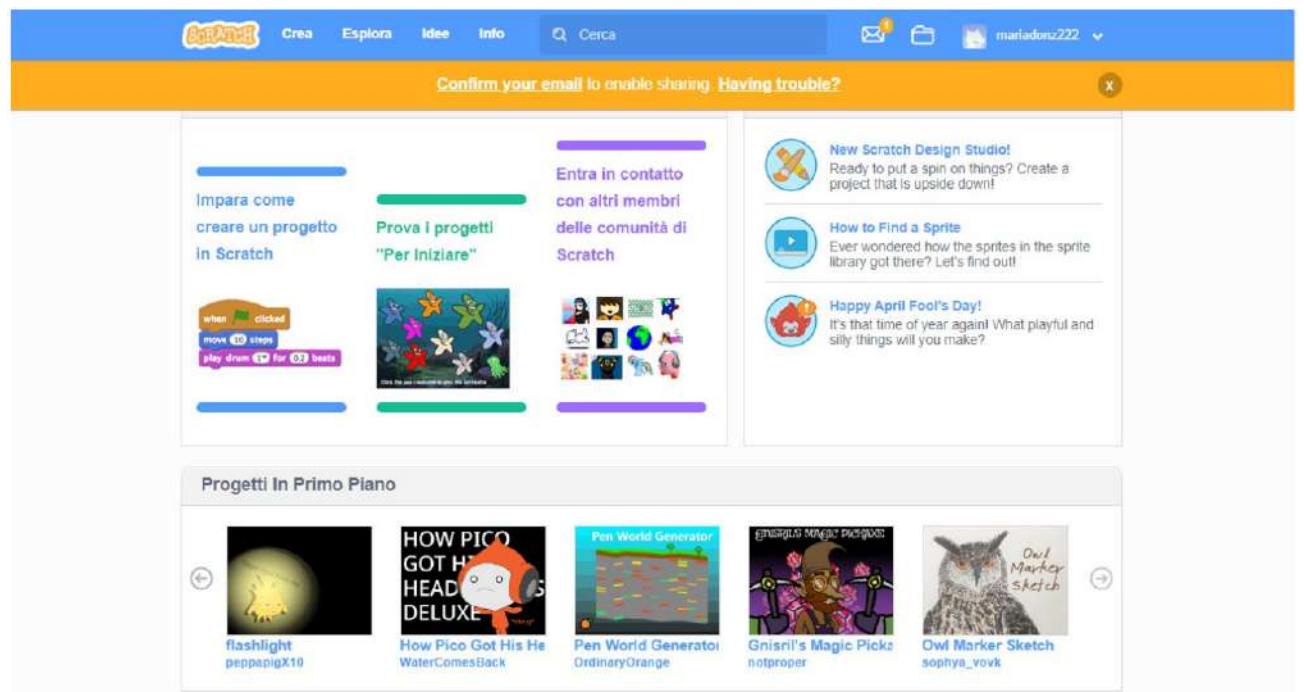


– To exit, click on your username at the top right and click on “Exit”.

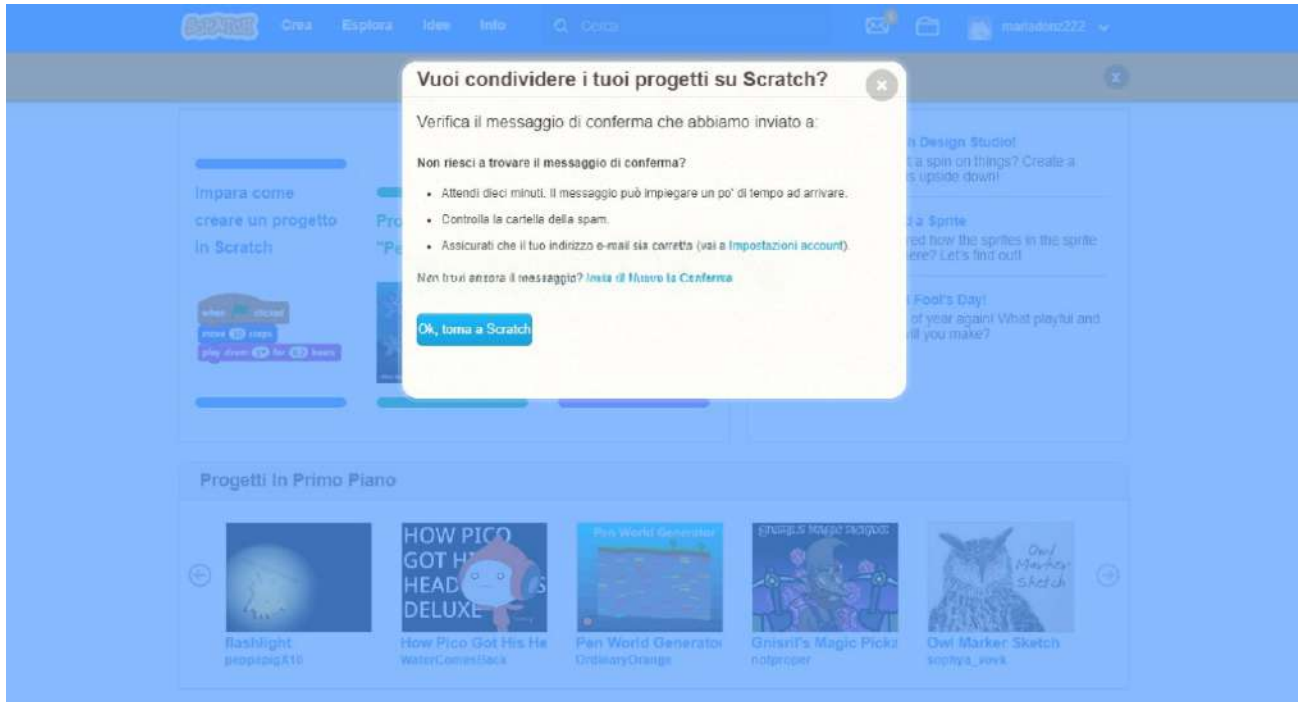
– To log back in with your credentials, click on “Log in” at the top right of the Scratch main page (next to “Join the Scratch community”).

PROBLEMS WITH SCRATCH ACCOUNT CONFIRMATION

– If you have not confirmed the account from your email address, an orange bar will appear at the top of the page asking you to confirm your account.



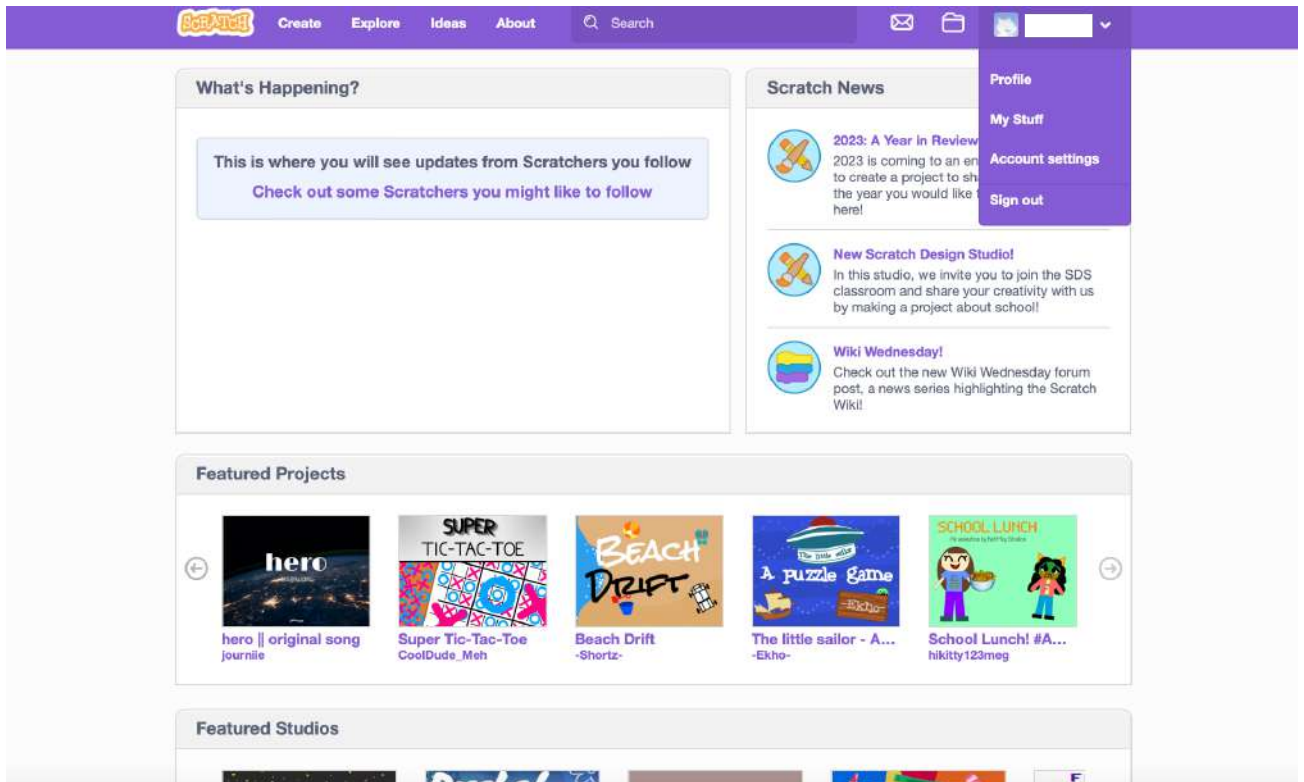
– If you do not receive a confirmation email, click on **“Confirm your email”**. A window will appear; click on **“Resend confirmation”**.



–If the confirmation email does not arrive one hour after clicking on **“Resend confirmation”**:

– click on your username at the top right of the Scratch page

– click on **“Account settings.”**



– click on **“Email.”**

– check that the email address under “**Current Email**” is written correctly

– if the email address is incorrect, enter the new address in the “**Type new Email**” box and click on “**Change Email.**”
